

## Readoption of County Ordinances

Title: An ordinance readopting the existing county code of O'Brien County, Iowa.

Be it Enacted by the Board of Supervisors of O'Brien County, Iowa:

Section 1. Purpose. Code of Iowa section 331.302, subsection nine, requires that once every five years a County shall compile its code of ordinances. This ordinance readopts ordinances already in effect.


Section 2. Readoption of Current Code. The following ordinances, have been previously adopted and enacted into law and were duly published as the law provides. They are state herein by number and subject matter and by the authority of the O'Brien County Board of Supervisors comprise O'Brien County code of Ordinances:


- No. 1 Level of Service for Snow & Ice removal on O'Brien County Secondary Roads, in its entirety.
- No. 2. Industrial Property Tax Credit Authorization, in its entirety.
- No. 3. Regulations for the Public Road Right-of-way, in its entirety.
- No. 4. Policy for separation of yard wastes, in its entirety.
- No. 5. Uniform Rural Address System, in its entirety.
- No. 6. Readoption of Existing ordinances, according to code. Done every 5 years in its entirety.
- No. 7. Ordinance to establish General Relief policies, in its entirety.
- No. 8. Local Option Sales & Services Tax, in its entirety.
- No. 9. Hazardous Materials – Establish who pays for spills, in its entirety.
- No. 10. Rules for the construction & abandonment of private water wells, in its entirety.
- No. 11. Readoption of Existing ordinances, according to code. Done every 5 years in its entirety.
- No. 12. Prohibition of Drug Paraphernalia – in its entirety.
- No. 13. Local Option Sales and Services Tax for the City of Hartley – in its entirety.
- No. 14. Purchase of Tax Sale Certificates on Parcels with Delinquent Taxes – in its entirety.
- No. 15. Septic System Guidelines – in its entirety.
- No. 16. Private Water Well construction Permits – in its entirety.
- No. 17. Voting Precincts – in its entirety.
- No. 18. Local Fee for Uniform Commercial Code Information – in its entirety.
- No. 19. Assessment of Wind Energy Conversion Property – in its entirety.
- No. 20. School Local Option Sales & Services Tax – in its entirety.
- No. 21. Urban Renewal Area #1 Project Area Property Taxes for Bond Payment – in its entirety.
- No. 22. Wind Energy Device Standards – in its entirety.

Section 3. Code of Ordinances. Copies of the code as adopted herein shall be on file and available for public inspection in the office of the County Auditor in the O'Brien County Courthouse. Primghar, Iowa.

Section 4. When Effective. This ordinance shall be effective after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
