

PROCEEDINGS OF O'BRIEN COUNTY SUPERVISORS

July 9, 2019

The Board of Supervisors met as per adjournment in regular session at 9:00 a.m. with all members present.

Moved by Friedrichsen, seconded by Steensma to approve the proceedings of July 2, 2019. Motion carried by all ayes.

At 9:05 a.m. a hearing was held on the proposed expansion of the Jungers LLC confinement feeding operation located in the NE ¼ NW ¼ of Section 1, Floyd Township. This is for a 3,200 head swine finisher building with manure storage for an existing swine confinement facility. The facility will have a capacity of 2,080 animal units (5,200 head of swine finishers) after construction. There were no objections or comments received. The Dept. of Natural Resources site review has not been scheduled at this time. The Board will delay their decision on the application until the review has taken place. Moved by McDowell, seconded by Steensma to close the hearing at 9:07 a.m. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Friedrichsen, seconded by Vanden Hull to appoint Dr. Amy Badberg as the O'Brien County Medical Examiner and Dr. Sara Zoelle, Dr. Amy Wingert, Dr. Ryan Becker, Dr. Scott Lichty and Dr. Josephine Dunn-Junis as Deputy Medical Examiners. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Steensma, seconded by Friedrichsen to accept the quote of Northern Truck for 2 pup trailers at \$46,529.00 each. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Friedrichsen, seconded by Vanden Hull to abate the taxes on Parcel 0046370000 in the amount of \$9,735 and Parcel 0046223000 in the amount of \$996; pursuant to Iowa Code 445.63. The parcels are now owned by the City of Sheldon. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by McDowell, seconded by Friedrichsen to approve the appointment of Debora Warnke as a part-time food service worker at \$15.14 per hour effective July 12, 2019. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by McDowell, seconded by Steensma to approve the quarterly reports for the quarter ending June 30, 2019 submitted by Allen Schuknecht, County Sheriff, Barbara Rohwer, County Auditor and Susan Smith, County Recorder. Motion carried by all ayes.
