

PROCEEDINGS OF O'BRIEN COUNTY SUPERVISORS

November 13, 2019

The Board of Supervisors met as per adjournment in regular session at 9:00 a.m. with all members present.

Moved by Steensma, seconded by Vanden Hull to approve the proceedings of November 5, 2019. Motion carried by all ayes.

The Board, as a Board of Canvassers, canvassed the results of the City/School Elections that were held on November 5, 2019 with the following declared elected: City Results: Archer Mayor Richard Ludeke; Archer Council – Bill Engeltjes & Steven Meyer; Archer Council to fill the vacancy – Todd Poland; Calumet Council – William Bill Robinson, Vickie Ann Rausch & Tyler Sechler; Calumet Council to fill vacancy – Regina Gina Loshman; Hartley Mayor Rodney Ahrenstorff; Hartley Council – Roxann Swanson & Jerry Olson; Paullina Mayor John Ihle; Paullina Council – Jay W. Jones, Jean A. Unrau & Lexy Murphy; Primghar Mayor Kurtis C. Edwards; Primghar Council – Kevin Buck Smith & Ryan J. Jenness; Sanborn Mayor Randy Lyman; Council – Tim Devitt, Aaron Wiekamp & Brian Visser; Sanborn Council to fill vacancy – Larry Reitsma; Sheldon Council 1st Ward – Pete Hamill; Sutherland Council - Chase Cox, Patrick Nelson & Bruce Engelke. Question QJ - Shall the City of Archer, Iowa, establish a capital improvement fund levy in an amount not to exceed sixty-seven and one-half cents per thousand dollars of taxable value per year for the purpose of accumulating moneys for the financing of specified capital improvements or carrying out a specific capital improvement plan, pursuant to Section 384.7 of the Iowa Code? Yes – 9 No – 33 Measure defeated. Question QK - Shall the City of Archer, Iowa be authorized to levy, annually, a property tax of twenty-seven cents per \$1,000 of assessed value for the purpose of increasing the annual operating budget of the Archer Public Library, with the collection of the levy commencing in the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020? Yes – 10 No – 32 Measure defeated. Question QL - Shall the City of Hartley, Iowa be authorized to levy, annually, a property tax of twenty-seven cents per \$1,000 of assessed value for the purpose of increasing the annual operating budget of the Hartley Public Library, with the collection of the levy commencing in the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020? Yes – 163 No – 52 Measure carried.

The results of the City of Sheldon Council at Large and Sheldon 3rd Ward seats along with the Utility Franchise questions were canvassed. These results will be finalized on November 18, 2019 when the Sioux County results are received for the final canvass.

The results of the Hartley-Melvin-Sanborn; Sheldon and South O'Brien School Districts were canvassed. These results will be finalized on November 18, 2019 when the results are received from the adjoining counties.

The results of the Clay Central-Everly, Floyd Valley MOC and Sioux Central Schools and the Northwest Iowa Community College and Iowa Lakes Community College were canvassed. They will be sent to the respective control counties for the final canvass.

Resolution for Transfer of Funds

WHEREAS, the O'Brien County Board of Supervisors have established an Ambulance Replacement Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Archer Ambulance Service has dissolved; and

WHEREAS, the Archer Ambulance Replacement fund has a balance of \$22,115.04 that O'Brien County holds in trust for ambulance replacement costs

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of O'Brien County, Iowa as follows:

The Archer Ambulance Replacement funds will be equally distributed to the remaining County Ambulance Services. \$3,685.84 will be transferred to the following trust funds held by the County: Hartley Ambulance Trust, Paullina Ambulance Trust, Primghar Ambulance Trust, Sanborn Ambulance Trust, Sheldon Ambulance Trust and Sutherland Ambulance Trust Fund from the Archer Ambulance Trust Fund.
