

PROCEEDINGS OF O'BRIEN COUNTY SUPERVISORS

April 21, 2020

The Board of Supervisors met as per adjournment in regular session at 9:06 a.m. with members McDowell present and Bootsma, Friedrichsen, Steensma and Vanden Hull via phone. This meeting is being held electronically due to the COVID-19 pandemic and restrictions imposed on the number of people allowed to assemble.

Moved by Vanden Hull, seconded by Bootsma to appoint Nancy McDowell as the Chair Pro-Tem. Roll call vote. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Friedrichsen, seconded by Vanden Hull to approve the proceedings of April 14, 2020 and April 16, 2020. Roll call vote. Motion carried by all ayes.

At 9:07 a.m. the second reading of Proposed County Ordinance No. 26: an ordinance prescribing the General Assistance Program in O'Brien County, Iowa was held. The purpose of this ordinance is to enact the authority established under Iowa Code Chapters 251, 252 and Iowa Constitutional Amendment 31, County Home Rule Amendment. This proposal makes changes from the existing General Assistance Ordinance to provide for emergency relief in the event of a Federal, State or County declared disaster that are not currently covered under the existing ordinance. There were no objections or comments presented.

Moved by Steensma, seconded by Vanden Hull to approve the second reading of Proposed County Ordinance No. 26: an ordinance prescribing the General Assistance Program in O'Brien County, Iowa and to adopt the ordinance as presented. Roll call vote. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Friedrichsen, seconded by Vanden Hull to authorize the Chair to sign the annual Certification of Cost Allocation Plan for indirect costs at the local Dept. of Human Services office for reimbursement during Fiscal 2021. Roll call vote. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Bootsma, seconded by Steensma to hold a budget amendment hearing at 9:05 a.m. May 19, 2020 for the Fiscal 2020 County budget. Roll call vote. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Friedrichsen, seconded by Steensma to approve the following claims to Thrifty White Drug for prescriptions at the jail in the amount of \$98.83; Bound Tree Medical, LLC for Equip. in the amount of \$2,369.80 and VISA for Equip. in the amount of \$4,563.73. Roll call vote. Motion carried by all ayes.

Moved by Steensma, seconded by Friedrichsen to adjourn to April 28, 2020. Roll call vote. Motion carried by all ayes.
